

## **Directions to Cracalt House from the Bus Station Car Park, Blackhall Road, Kendal.**

There is only one exit for vehicles from the car park but there are two lanes. Get in the right hand lane for exit and turn right after the barrier- you might have to wait a while to get across the traffic.

Follow the one-way system left and then, almost immediately, right where another lane joins from your left. Get into the left-hand lane and bear left and right over the bridge across the River Kent.

Keep in the left hand lane to the end of the one-way system and then carry on a short distance to a roundabout.

Approach the roundabout in the right hand lane and take the second exit, signposted for Natland.

You shortly leave the town and after nearly a mile of countryside you approach the village of Natland.

Opposite a farm entrance there is a dog-leg of a junction but basically you carry straight on (in other words bear slightly left whilst ignoring a road coming in from the right and then bear right ignoring a road coming in from the left).

Shortly you will pass Holmes Garden Centre on your left hand side and then, on your right, you will see a large Victorian building called Appletree set back on your right.

Immediately after Appletree, on your right is a narrow lane. Turn right down this lane and, after 50 yards, keep left at the fork. After another 50 yards or so there is a gate on your left into the field in which we hope you will be able to park.

Cracalt House is another 50 yards further on at the end of the lane.
